**Explanation:**

**Topic of the day** is intended to be an over-arching theme of a day activity. The selection of 5 should reflect the focus FEPS wants to give to when talking about European democracy

**Lecture** is to be a moment when prominent academics introduce the topic. Lecture is to be 25-30 minutes, leaving a couple minutes for eventual questions

**Special Guest Sessions** are to be the exclusive sessions with the invited high level guest speakers, who will be asked to engage in an exchange / conversation with the participants (avoiding speeches).

**Debates** are to be one hour session with maximum two speakers, focused on the selected topics – with short introductory intervention and space for debate

**Country Case Studies / Thematic Workshops / Visits** are small rounds (10 – 15 people) with 2 or 3 speakers, enabling to zoom in and learn

**Video messages:** key actors of social movements or youth policies explain their experience, their role and their involvement in the topic.

**Ice breaking and quiz** is to be a kick off start moment, enabling participants to get to know each other and in a fun way learn new things by responding to quiz

**Optional Master Class** are four practical classes, which are facultative and are meant to offer technical knowledge about selected topic

**Future Workshop** is an interactive methodology to find a common solution (action plan) to a given problem

**Closing ceremony** will be a moment to summarise the event
