Profile of the participants: 4th Annual Autumn Academy is open to the participants, who:

- Are promising young politicians
- Are activists already elected or have been candidates for an elected positions (within the party / NGOs structures, local / regional / national level)
- Command fluent English
- Are ready to commit to follow the entire programme
- Are nominated by FEPS Member Foundations, PES Sister Parties, YES and its members, FEPS AAA alumni 2019 -2021

FEPS is committed to make sure that:

- There is a minimum of 1 participant from all the respective EU Member States
- While the participants from the Member States are considered a delegation – that the latter remains gender balanced

Registration

The nominating stakeholders are requested to provide FEPS with:

- A nomination (via email)
- A bio of the nominee

Before sending these to FEPS, we would recommend to the stakeholders to check the availability of the potential nominees – whom FEPS Team will be contacting directly to inform them about further steps of the registration procedures

Participation fee

When it comes to the costs, moving towards contributions is inevitable but at the same time FEPS remains committed to the program and to fairness. Each FEPS member organization can nominate one participant for free and the second one for a fee of 250 euros. Nominations after 3rd October will rise to 500 euros.

Travel, accommodation, board and programme

FEPS will be in charge of organising the FEPS AAA programme, accommodation, meals and travel (that will be booked by the FEPS Team).



Programme

The participants are expected to take an active part from the beginning till the end in order to be eligible for both the end of the seminar certificates and for the travel reimbursements respectively.

Privacy

This means that we ask everyone involved not to share any content externally and all the eventual quotes / pictures have to be cleared with the persons they involve.
